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IMPORTANT DISCLAIMER:

Due to recent federal policy changes, there is significant uncertainty around gender marker updates for passports and birth certificates. Some applications are being indefinitely delayed, and there is no clear guidance on how agencies will process these requests moving forward.

At this time, we recommend waiting to submit changes or making international travel plans until more clarity is provided. We encourage you to follow the trusted resources below closely as this situation continues to evolve.

In Michigan, trans people can legally change their <u>names</u>.

To do so, they must:

- Appear before a judge for a court hearing on the name change.
- Publish notice of the hearing in a local newspaper in the county where they live.*
- If you are a minor, you must also obtain parental or guardian consent.
- If you are 22 years of age or older, you must also complete a fingerprint criminal background check.

*Michigan court rules were recently updated to allow a waiver of the publication requirement in certain cases, including when there is a risk of harassment (which may apply to many transgender folx). Here is a <u>resource</u> on how to pursue this option.

Trans Healthcare and Insurance

- Michigan's Medicaid policy explicitly allows for transition-related care.
- Private insurers cannot refuse to cover healthcare services for trans people that they would cover for cis people in Michigan.⁶
- A therapist's letter is not legally required to start hormones in Michigan, and WPATH standards do not mandate one. However, individual providers may set their own requirements, and some may still require a letter.
- Different healthcare and insurance providers have different policies regarding minors' access to puberty blockers and HRT in Michigan.
 - Minors require parental consent for both puberty blockers and hormone therapy.
- Minors generally need parental consent for medical and surgical care, but minors can receive limited outpatient mental health services, Title X family planning services, and STI diagnosis and treatment without parental consent.⁸
- As of 2024, Michigan legislation now prohibits mental health providers from subjecting LGBTQ+ youth to the abusive practice of conversion therapy.⁹



In Michigan, trans people can legally change their <u>gender</u> <u>markers</u> on their state IDs, licenses, birth certificates, and passports without undergoing medical treatments.

- The Michigan Department of State now offers a nonbinary (X) gender marker option.²
- Recent updates also allow individuals to self-certify their gender marker selection, eliminating the previous requirement for a clinician's approval.
- Trans youth cannot change their names or genders on their birth certificates without a parent or guardian (unless they are emancipated).^{3*}
- The U.S. Department of State allows trans youth to change their gender markers on their passports without medical certification and offers a nonbinary (X) gender marker option.⁴
 - Youth under 16 must have two parents or guardians approve their gender marker change.
 - Youth between 16 and under 18 years old must show that one parent or guardian approves of their gender marker change.⁵

*Michigan birth certificates do not currently offer a nonbinary or intersex marker.
