<p>HB 4664/4665 and SB 327, 357/358 : Require Fetal Heartbeat Detection Before Abortion</p> <p>These bills would mandate that medical professionals check for a fetal heartbeat before performing an abortion. <p>HB 5179-5185 and SB 622-628 : Create Reproductive Health Act and Repeal Abortion Restrictions</p> <p>These bills would create a new Reproductive Health Act that asserts the "fundamental rights" of all people to choose or refuse contraception/sterilization, and if pregnant, the right to give birth or have an abortion. They would also appeal many of the current restrictions surrounding abortion, including the pre-Roe v.
